### Exhibit Description

Zufall's Spring 2020 art exhibit is an interactive show that invites audience participation. All artwork will be listed as "Untitled" while on display. During the exhibit, viewers will be invited to submit their own title suggestions for individual artwork. This will be a fun way to show what emotions and ideas your work provokes in viewers. The suggested titles will later be displayed along with the artist's original title to show the artist's intention vs. the viewer's reaction to the artwork. Artists may submit artwork of any theme as representational, abstract and conceptual works of art, ranging from drawings, paintings, collage, and photographic and digital art.

Art Drop-off:	Beginning March 9, 2020

### Submission Process

- **Your Name:** First and Last
- **Exhibit Name:** Zufall Health – “Untitled”
- **Contact Information:** Phone/email address/website/ mailing address
- **Photos of your work:** Submit jpegs clearly labeled with the artist name, title, and size (ex. john\_smith\_title\_36x48). You may submit up to 10 artworks for consideration.
- **Medium** (ex. Acrylic on canvas, oil on wood panel, mixed media)
- **Prices of your work** if applicable.

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## Details and Rules

- Artists must be over 18 years of age.
- All artwork must be the artist's original work.
- Artists may submit no more than 10 artworks for consideration.
- All work must be ready for hanging with hooks and wire on the back. Artwork without proper hanging wire will not be displayed.
- **Prohibited subjects** include political statements, commercial advertising, and subject matter not suited for a public display space and/or minors.
- Zufall Health reserves the right to refuse art that does not conform to the above standards.
- The selection committee has final say on determining the eligibility of the artwork.
- **Insurance:** The artists must insure their own art. Zufall Health is a secure, professional building and all consideration and measures will be taken to secure the art.
- Zufall Health and the Exhibit Curator, Amanda Barron, are not responsible for any stolen, damaged or broken artwork and frames with glass. Plexiglass is a better option for framed pieces.
- Zufall Health **does not** charge any commission in case of sales. Any sale transactions will be directly between the artist and purchaser.
