## MEET THE SPEAKER

Marc Gimbel, DMD, a Diplomate of the American Board of Endodontics, has been practicing dentistry and endodontics for more than three decades. Currently in private practice in Montville, N.J., he is a Clinical Assistant Professor at the Rutgers School of Dental Medicine Department of Endodontics where he teaches at the post-graduate level. He also volunteers at Zufall Health working with dental residents to provide underserved patients critical access to specialty services. Over the years, he has been listed among the top dentists in the state by New Jersey Monthly Magazine. He also was awarded the Certificate of Merit from the Harvard University Department of Endodontics and invited back to lecture. Earning a bachelor's degree in biology/chemistry from the State University of New York at Albany, he received his DMD from the University of Pennsylvania School of Dental Medicine and completed post-graduate education in the field of endodontics at the University of Medicine and Dentistry of New Jersey. His professional affiliations include the American Association of Endodontists, the American Dental Association, the New Jersey Dental Association, and the Tri-County Dental Society.
