COURSE DESCRIPTION

Approved by the New Jersey Radiologic Technology Board of Examiners, this free course includes didactic (25 actual hours), laboratory (20 actual hours), and 40 actual hours of supervised clinical instruction to prepare individuals for the Radiation Health and Safety (RHS) examination used to qualify for New Jersey dental radiology licensure. Upon completion of the course, the student will demonstrate an in-depth knowledge of radiographic principles and techniques necessary for the effective and safe production and utilization of diagnostic dental x-rays in preparation for licensure in New Jersey.

COURSE REQUIREMENTS

- Statement of Good Moral Character (criminal background check)
- Successful completion of a four-year course of study in a secondary school (high school) approved by the State Board of Education or passed an approved equivalency test. Zufall Health Inc will verify with the state's department of education that the high school is approved/recognized; applicants with foreign education diploma must be evaluated for equivalency to at least a high school education received in the United States; and graduates of New Jersey home schooling must also possess a state issued GED as part of their application before acceptance into the program.
